In the Matter of Additional strips of Badenhill Common, Tytherington, Avon

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.G/CL 331 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 600 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 7 March 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 21 July 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr E W Oakey, the Chairman of the Tytherington Parish Council, and by Miss D Jenkins Evans, Solicitor, on behalf of the Avon County Council, the successor authority of the Objector. There was no appearance on behalf of the Northavon District Council, the successor authority of the former Thornbury Rural District Council, the applicant for the registration.

The Objection relates to only a part of the land comprised in the Register Unit, which forms part of county highways maintainable at the public expense.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification, namely, the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
