

In the Matter of Assley, Hareley, Hawkesbury, and Inglestone Commons, Hawkesbury, Avon (No. ...3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 3 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 38 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 66 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 21 July 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr V H Harris, solicitor, on behalf of Mr J W Blakeney, Mr D J Blakeney, and Mr J W Blakeney, junior, the applicants for the conflicting registration. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the applicant for the registration.

Mr Harris stated that he was instructed to agree to the confirmation of the registration with a modification in the description of the dominant tenement.

I therefore confirm the registration with the following modification; namely, the deletion of the words from "and adjoining lands" to the end of the entry in column 5.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
