



In the Matter of Assley, Hareley, Hawkesbury, and
Inglestone Commons, Hawkesbury, Avon (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 70 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 38 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Avon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 92 made by the former Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 31 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bath on 21 July 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr V H Harris, solicitor, on behalf of Mr J W Blakeney, Mr D J Blakeney, and Mr J W Blakeney, junior, the applicants for the registration at Entry No. 66 (Mr J W Blakeney and Mr D J Blakeney being also the applicants for the registrations at Entry Nos 67 and 69 respectively) and Mr F E M Moreton, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 68, and by Miss D Jenkins-Evans of the Commons Registration Section of the Avon County Council.

The Objection relates solely to the inclusion in the Lands section of the Register Unit of certain roads and paths. Since by my decision in In the Matter of Assley, etc. Commons, Hawkesbury (No. 1), 1981 Ref. No. 260/D/157 I have confirmed the registration in the Lands section with certain modifications, the Objection is no obstacle to the confirmation of the registrations in the Rights section. However, a number of the registrations in the Rights section are also the subject of disputes occasioned by conflicting registrations. I shall deal with those registrations in my decisions on those disputes. It therefore remains for me to confirm the remaining registrations, namely, those at Entry Nos 1, 2, 4 - 6, 8 - 12, 14 - 20, 22 - 27, 29 - 43, 45 ^{46, 51-} ~~50~~ and 70.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
