

In the Matter of Snelsmore Common, Winterbourne, Berkshire

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Snelsmore Common, Winterbourne being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL 91 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Berkshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Newbury on 31 January 1978.

At the hearing the Winterbourne Parish Meeting was represented by Mr A H Just its Clerk, but Mr Just informed me that he was making no claim to the land in question.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
