



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.271/D/13

In the Matter of a Tract of Land of about
1900 acres called Halkyn Common, Holywell

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.11 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Clwyd County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.7 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Mold on 9th January 1975.

For the reasons set out in my decision under reference 271/D/12 I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulations 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
