



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 51/D/168 and 169

In the Matter of Land at Horseshoe Bass or
Llantysilio Mountain, Llantysilio and Llandegla,
Glyndwr D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry Nos. 1 to 15 inclusive in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL. 74 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 40 made by Duncan Robertson and noted in the Register on 23 September 1970, and by Objection No. 113 made by C S Bond entered in the Register on 4 May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangollen on 30 & 31 March and 1 April 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Sopwith on behalf of Mr Duncan Robertson and all the applicants for rights attended by their legal representatives, or agents or in person. It was agreed by all the interested parties that I should refuse to confirm Entry Nos. 2 to 15 inclusive and that I should confirm Entry No. 1 modified by inserting after the words "comprised in this Register Unit" in the 4th column the following words viz:- "and Unit No. CL. 22 but so that the total number of sheep grazed at any one time over this Unit and CL. 22 shall not exceed 120 ewes."

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
