



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 51/D/71

In the Matter of Part of Llantysilio Mountain,
Bryneglwyn, Glyndwr D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 1 to 12 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL. 122 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 42 made by Mr Duncan Robertson and noted in the Register on 23 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangollen on 30 & 31 March and 1 April 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr T A G Sopwith the agent for Mr Duncan Robertson and all the applicants for Rights either by their respective legal representative or their agent or in person. All the applicants for rights have applied for rights to graze their respective flocks over other Units on the Llantysilio Mountain. This Unit comprises on 9.6 acres and it was accepted by all the applicants for rights under Entries 1 to 11 inclusive that only the flock of the applicant under Entry No. 12 grazed on this small area, and that I should refuse to confirm the Entries 1 to 11 inclusive.

The applicant under Entry No. 12 is also entitled to graze his flock on Units CL. 21, CL. 22, CL. 123 and CL. 128 and I confirm his Entry No. 12 modified so as to provide that the number of sheep grazed by him on this Unit and the above-mentioned Units at any one time shall not exceed 400 sheep and 400 lambs.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
