## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 494 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X1143 made by Mrs J D Elliott and noted in the Register on 21 November 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 24 June 1980. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but since I have refused to confirm the registration in the Land section of the Register Unit, it only remains for me to refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
