

In the Matter of Deepdale Common, Patterdale, Cumbria (NO.2)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 8 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.160 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 5 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.57.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 29 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr D Mellor, Solicitor, on behalf of Ms E A Little and Miss M A Robinson, the applicants for the registrations at Entry Nos 2,7 and 8 in Register Unit No.CL.160 and at Entry Nos 2, 4 and 5 in Register Unit No.CL.57.

The conflict is more apparent than real, having been caused by an error on the part of the former Westmorland County Council as registration authority. corrected this error by my decision relating to the registration in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.160, by which certain land is excluded from that registration. That, however, does not affect in any way the validity of the registrations the subject of this reference in relation to the land still comprised in Register Unit No.CL.160.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations, the subject of this reference.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
