

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 264/D /512

In the Matter of Field No. 0S 752 near Sellafield, Seascale

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry No. 1, 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 409 in the Register of Common Land maintained by Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 201 made by British Nuclear Fuels Ltd and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Whitehaven on 25 November 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr Greer of the Registration Authority: by Mr F G Lamble, Solicitor, appearing for the applicants for registration of the Entries in the Rights Section: and by Mr N Wright, of Counsel, appearing on behalf of the Objector. Mr C Vane, of Counsel, was also in attendance, appearing on behalf of the Earl of Lonsdale, who claims ownership of the land in question.

There are two Entries in the Rights Section, both numbered 1. Mr Wright told me that the Objection was now withdrawn and accordingly I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
