COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Four Plots of Land between the two Rows of Houses known as North Row and South Row, Roose, Earrow-in-Furness, Cumbria

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 2 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1 made by the former Barrow-in-Furness County Borough Council and noted in the Register on 5 February 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Barrow-in-Furness on 16 October 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr D A Robinson, a supporter of the registration, and Mr C A Parker, the Assistant Solicitor of the Barrow-in-Furness Borough Council.

After a short adjournment for a discussion between Mr Robinson and Mr Parker, Mr Robinson informed me that he did not wish to call evidence in support of the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
