

In the Matter of Langstrath and Coombe Fells, Borrowdale, Cumbria (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 5 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 423 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 195 made by the National Trust and noted in the Register on 25 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Keswick on 11 November 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr P Fitzgerald, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector, which is also the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 1. I gave leave for Lodore Ltd, the applicant for the registrations at Entry No. 2 and 5 to be represented by Mr P Ling, their agent.

Mr Fitzgerald and Mr Ling informed me that it had been agreed that the right the subject of the registration at Entry No. 2 should be exercisable only over the land to the west of langstrath Beck.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations at Entry Nos 1, 3, 4 and 5, and I confirm the registration at Entry No. 2 with the following modification:— namely, by the substitution for the words "whole of the land comprising this register unit" of the words "part of the land comprising this register unit to the west of Langstrath Beck".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
