In the Matter of Parcels of land called Hilton Village Green, Murton, Eden Ristrict

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entries Nos. 2, 8, 10 and 16 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. VG 6 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Cumbria County Council. They are occasioned by Objections Nos. 2/50, 2/96, 2/104 and 2/59 made by the Ministry of Defence and noted in the Register in July and August 1971.

I held a hearing (adjourned from 19 May 1981) for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Keswick on 10 July 1984. At the hearing the Minister was represented by Mr J D Howes, on behalf of the Treasury Solicitor, and Mr P Birtles, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of the Hilton Commoners Committee.

The Objections were withdrawn and accordingly I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
