



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 209/D/173

In the Matter of the pieces of land called the Leat and the Common together with the Bed of the River Culm

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.41 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Devon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 3 made by George Small (Devon) Ltd and noted in the Register on 4 December 1960.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exeter on 2 June 1981. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard. The Uffculme Parish Council had withdraw its application.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
