

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 10/D/14

In the Matter of Church Green, Verwood, Dorset (No.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 49 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. C.L. 49 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 452 made by the Dorset County Council and noted in the Register on 10th March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 11th May 1972. The hearing was attended by Mr. G.F. Thomas, the Clerk of the Verwood Parish Council, and the Objectors were not represented.

The grounds of the objection are that certain parts of the land are part of the highway. I have, however, considered this registration in Reference No. 10/D/13 and have come to the conclusion that none of the land comprised in it is common land. It is therefore not necessary for me to consider the grounds of this objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
