

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 210/D/255

In the Matter of Gorse Hill Common, Poole, Dorset

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 233 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.233 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection 151 made by the Town Clerk of the former Borough of Poole and noted in the Register on 3 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 29 November 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr L W Heeler, the Assistant Secretary of the Ramblers' Association, the applicant for the registration, Mr L Streatfield, whose application was noted under section 4 (4) of the Commons Registration Act 1965, and Mr R M Wickenden, the Deputy Town Clerk of Poole.

Mr Wickenden informed me that he was instructed not to support the objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
