

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 210/D/74, 75 & 76

In the Matter of Horton Common, Holt, Wimborne D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 19 in the Land Section and Entry Nos 2, 5 and 6 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL. 20 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection Nos 348 and 349 both made by Captain E W B Fryer and both noted in the Register on 3 June 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into these disputes at Bournemouth on 28 April 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr L Flynn of Messrs Ward Bowie on behalf of Captain Fryer, Mr R G Faulkner on behalf of Holt Parish Council and on behalf of the applicants for Rights at Entry Nos 5 and 6 and Mr Thorne of Messrs Phillip Evans on behalf of the successor to the applicant for Rights at Entry No 2. Mr Faulkner and Mr Thorne stated that the Entries in the Land Section and the Rights Section were made in error and were content that I should refuse to confirm all the registrations.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the above mentioned registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
