



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 1 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Durham County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 25 made by the former Durham County Council and noted in the Register on 16 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Durham on 1 July 1980. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but the Durham County Council stated in a letter dated 12 June 1980, addressed to the Clerk to the Commons Commissioners, that the Objection would not be pursued.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
