



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 37/D/95-106

In the Matter of Ashdown Forest, Forest Row,  
Hartfield, Withyham, Maresfield, Danehill and  
Buxted, East Sussex.

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 46, 158, 236, 263, 317, 318, 343, 435, 503, 504, 63, and 424 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.1 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former East Sussex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 13 made by the Conservators of Ashdown Forest and noted in the Register on 19 February 1970, and Objections Nos, 75, 78, 81, 85, 86, 87, 89, 93, 94, 133, and 147 also made by the Conservators of Ashdown Forest and all noted in the Register on 30 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lewes on 17 November 1978. The hearing was attended by Cdr Angell, the Clerk to the Objectors. There was no appearance by or on behalf of any of the applicants for the registrations.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm all the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
