

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.37/D/82

In the Matter of Land at Chuck Hatch and Golden Castle, Hartfield, East Sussex (No.3)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 58 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former East Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.9 made by Col.and Mrs R.E.Burton and noted in the Register on 5th December 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lewes on 21st November 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr R.Glover, the husband of Mrs E.R.Glover, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr A.K.Baird, the successor in title of Col. and Mrs Burton.

The Objection relates to only a small part of the land comprised in the Register Unit, and Mr Glover stated that Mrs Glover had not intended that this registration should extend to the land the subject of the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification: - namely the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
