



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of The Village Green,
Hartfield, East Sussex(No.1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG 20 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former East Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.61 made by the County Council and noted in the Register on 30th October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lewes on 21st November 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr D.H.F.Armstrong, the Chairman of the Hartfield Parish Council, which applied for the registration, and by Mr W.L.Clements, solicitor, on behalf of the East Sussex County Council.

The land comprised in the Register Unit is crossed by two public footpaths. The Objection relates only to the sites of these paths.

This case is indistinguishable in principle from In the Matter of Rowheath, Chailey (1974) 37/D/18, and for the reasons given in my decision in that case I confirm the registration without modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
