

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 213/D/70 & 71

In the Matter of Jacks Green, Sheepscombe, Painswick, Stroud D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entries 1 and 2 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 163 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Gloucestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No Ob 505 made by Gloucestershire County Council and noted in the Register on 8 December 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Gloucester on 12 October 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Lipscombeon behalf of Gloucestershire County Council who satisfied me that all the persons entitled to be heard agreed that the land identified on the plan annexed to Objection No Ob 505 should be excluded from the Entry in the Land Section. I therefore confirm that Entry modified by the exclusion of the said land and I confirm Entries Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights Section as applicable to the modified Entry in the Land Section.

I apologise for the delay in giving this decision which was attributable to my having mislaid the files and I am grateful to the Registration Authority for its assistance.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in</u> point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
