



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Mynydd Cerrig Gwynion
and Mynydd Tyn-y-Maes, Llanymawddwy,
Meirionnydd D

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Mynydd Cerrig Gwynion and Mynydd Tyn-y-Maes, Llanymawddwy, Meirionnydd D being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 156 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owners.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Mr D J Humphreys claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Dolgellau on 30 July 1976.

Mr G Lloyd of Messrs Guthrie Jones & Jones appeared for Mr Humphreys. Mr Humphreys gave evidence that he remembered the land in question having been completely fenced in for approximately 58 years, and that he had had exclusive enjoyment of the land free from any interference from Mr Edwards on his eastern boundary, or Mr Williams on his western boundary or any other person.

On this evidence I am satisfied that Mr D J Humphreys is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Gwynedd County Council, as registration authority, to register D J Humphreys as the owner of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
