



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.274/D/104 and 105

In the Matter of Tracts of land known as  
Mynydd Pentre, Tal-y-Fran, Mynydd Esgair  
Weddan Braich Ddu, Taren Cwm-Ffernol, Dolau-

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL.235 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Meirionth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.40 made by Col J F Williams Wynne CBE DSO and noted in the Register on 25 September 1970 and objection No.305 made by the Merioneth Branch of the N F O noted in the register on 26 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dolgellau on 19 April 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr D Williams on behalf of the N F U who produced a signed consent by Mr A Ian Mattingly the Registration made by the Ramblers Association.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
