

In the Matter of Green Lane, Old Hills, Powick, Hereford and Worcester (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 12 (inclusive) in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 112 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Worcestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 60 made by the Trustees of the Madresfield Estate and noted in the Register on 5 February 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Worcester on 30 November 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr V F Bohn, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 2, and by Mr J D Schooling, solicitor, on behalf of the Objectors. I also gave leave to Mr Bohn to represent Mr E C Lanay, Mr H Parsons, Mr G S Holland, Mr D H Thomas, Mr W L Rees-Pinchen, Mr M Knibbs, and Mr N A Saunders, the applicants for the registrations at Entry Nos. 1, 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11.

For the reasons given in my decision in <u>In the Matter of Green Lane, Old Hills, Powick</u> (1977), Ref No. 215/D/120 I have come to the conclusion that the land comprised in the Register Unit does not fall within the definition of "common land" in section 22(1) of the Commons Registration Act 1965.

It therefore follows that I refuse to confirm the registrations the subject of this distate.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in toint of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
