## DECISION

nis reference relates to the question of the ownership of land on the South de of Main Street, Skidby, being the land comprised in the Land Section of egister Unit No.VG.42 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained the Humberside County Council of which no person is registered under ection 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

ollowing upon the public notice of this reference Mrs J Pelling claimed to be e freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have formation as to its ownership.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership the land at Beverley on 17 January 1979.

the hearing, Mrs Pelling appeared in person.

s Pelling is the owner of a tlacksmith's shop adjoining the eastern end of the und comprised in the Register Unit and she was under the impression that her property d been included in the Register Unit, but she made no claim to be the owner of the nd to the west.

the absence of any evidence as to the land comprised in the Register Unit I am t satisfied that any person is the owner of that land, and I shall accordingly rect the Humberside CountyCouncil, as registration authority, to register the idby Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8 (3) of the Act of 1965.

am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to plain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law y, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, quire me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
