In the Matter of The Green and Pond, Bishop Burton, Beverley R.D., Yorkshire (East Riding)

## **DECISION**

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land (two pieces land and land covered by water) known as The Green and Pond and north of the Main ll-York Road, in Bishop Burton, Beverley Rural District being the land comprised the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.20 in the Register of Town or Village Greens intained by the East Riding County Council of which no person is registered under ction 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be e freehold owner of the land in question and no person claimed to have information to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the pership of the land at Beverley on 12 July 1973. No person attended the hearing.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the ner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the East Riding County Council, as gistration authority, to register Bishop Burton Parish Council as the owner of the ad under section 8 (3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 71 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to a, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
