## In the Matter of Bank Bottom, Grindleton, Lancashire (No.2)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.480 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 81 made by Ms E M Heaton and noted in the Register on 2 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Blackburn on 19 June 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr W R King-Wilkinson, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr C.Sutcliffe, the successor in title of the Objector. There was no appearance on behalf of the Grindleton Parish Council, the applicant for the registration.

In the absence of any evidence to support the registration, I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
