In the Matter of Salt Marshes, Warton and Silverdale, Lancashire (NO.1)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.45 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 1 made by the former Lancaster Rural District Council, Objection No. 70 made by Mr J Wilkinson, and Objection No. 75 made by Thos. W Ward Ltd and all noted in the Register on 4 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lancaster on 1 and 2 March 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr J Leeming, of Counsel, on behalf of Mr J P Merrett, the applicant for the registration, the Trustees of H M Reynolds, deceased, the applicants for the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of the Register Unit and Mr C L Mason, the applicant for the Registration at Entry No. 4 in the Rights Section, by Mr L Howarth, Solicitor, on behalf Mr J Wilkinson, (also the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 5 in the Rights Section), and by Mr R B Armstrong, the Vice -Chairman of the Warton Parish Council. At the hearing I was informed that it had been agreed that the south-eastern boundary of the land comprised in the Register Unit should be the main channel of the River Keer.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification, namely the exclusion of the land to the south-east of the main channel of the River Kennotwithstanding that the position of the said channel may change from time to time due either to accretion or to erosion.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
