## In the Matter of Site of Old Cottages, Washdyke Lane, Nettleham, Lincolnshire, (Parts of Lindsey)

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.C.L.48 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No.OB/26 made by Mrs. M.E. Dickinson and noted in the Register on 8th May 1972, and by Objection No.OB/28 made by the County Council and noted in the Register on 15th June 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Lincoln on 12th March 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr. A. Clark, solicitor, on behalf of the Nettleham Parish Council, the Applicant for the registration and by Mrs. Dickinson in person. There was no appearance on behalf of the County Council. Mr. Clark informed me that the Parish Council had decided not to pursue the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

By consent, I shall make an order that the Parish Council pay Mrs. Dickinson's costs to be taxed on County Court Scale 2.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
