



In the Matter of Leasowe Common, Wirral, Merseyside  
(No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL.1 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Merseyside County Council and are occasioned by Objections Nos 2 and 3 both made by the former Wallasey Corporation and noted in the Register on 6 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chester on 27 June 1984. The hearing was attended by Miss C Booth of the Administration and Legal Department of the Wirral Metropolitan District Council, the successor authority of the former Wallasey Corporation. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr G P De Brotherton, the applicant for the registration.

In the absence of any evidence in support of the registration I refuse to confirm it.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
