

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.25/D/186

In the Matter of Sutton Staithe, Sutton, Norfolk (No.3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.2 in the Cwnership Section of Register Unit No.VG 30 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No.1 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 24th April 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr Colin Lamb, of counsel, on behalf of the Smallburgh Internal Drainage Board, the applicant for the registration, and by Major R.A.F.Kemp, the Clerk of the Sutton Parish Council, the applicant for the conflicting registration.

For the reasons given in my decision in <u>In the Matter of Sutton Staithe</u> (No.2) (1975), Ref. Nos. 25/D/185, 25/D/187 I have confirmed the conflicting registration with the exclusion of certain land, including that the subject of this registration, and for the reasons there given I confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
