COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Carlsmoor (part), Laverton, Harrogate B

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 511 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1654 made by G S Bostock and noted in the Register on 1 May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Harrogate on 12 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr R Wakefield, of Counsel, appearing on behalf of Mr Bostock, and by Mr B Kealy, of Counsel, appearing on behalf of Mrs M H Butlin, the applicant for the registration.

Mr Kealy told me that his client does not now claim the rights registered, and accordingly I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
