

In the Matter of Cowton Moor, East Cowton, Morth Yorkshire (No. 2)

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 194 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Horth Riding of Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection Mos Oll4 and Oll5 made by Mr S G Leggott and Mr A Leggott and both noted in the Register on 13 August 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Northallerton on 8 March 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr S Crisp, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr F Such, of counsel, on behalf of the Objectors.

For the reasons given in my decision in <u>In the Matter of Cowton Moor, East Cowton</u> (No. 1), (1977), Ref. No. 268/D/136 I am not satisfied that Mr Crisp is entitled to a right of common over any of the land comprised in the Register Unit.

I therefore refuse to confirm the registration. I shall order Ir Crisp to pay the Objectors' costs on County Court Scale 4.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
