



In the Matter of Ten End Peat Moor, Wether Fell and Waste Land, Hawes, North Yorkshire (No. 1).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 145 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 013 made by Mr A J Rowntree and noted in the Register on 8 May 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Richmond on 21 July 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr E R D Johnson, solicitor, on behalf of the Lord's Trustees of the Manor of Bainbridge, the applicants for the registration, and by Mr J S Huntington, solicitor, on behalf of Mr Rowntree's executors.

Mr Johnson informed me that his clients were content that the land the subject of the Objection should be excluded from the Register Unit.

In these circumstances it only remains for me to confirm the registration with the following modification: - namely, the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
