

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.26/D/27

In the Matter of Kislingbury House Green.
Kislingbury, Northampton R.D., Northamptonshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit Ho.C.L.8 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Morthamptonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.34 made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 19th October 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons which are that a ten foot strip of land on the south east side of the land comprised in this Register Unit abutting the carriage way was not common land at the date of the registration but then was and still forms part of the public highway and that accordingly the Parish Council agree to the withdrawal of the registration of such land as common land and the County Council agree to the registration of the remainder of Hislingbury House Green as common land and withdraws its objection thereto.

I am willing to give a decicion in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modification:— a ten foot atrip on the south east side of the land comprised in this Register Unit and abutting the carriage way to be removed from the Register.
