

COMMINS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.26/D/20

In the Matter of the Two Pieces of land called the Green, Kislingbury, Northampton R.D., Northamptonshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. C.L.7 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Northamptonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.33 made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 19th October 1970.

All persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, which terms are that the whole of the small triangular area of land abutting on Church Lane and comprised in the said unit together with a ten foot strip of land on the south and south-east sides of the remainder of the said unit abutting the metalled carriage way was not common land at the date of the registration but then was and still forms part of the public highway and that accordingly the Parish Council agree to the withdrawal of the registration of such land as common land and the County Council agree to the registration of the remainder of the green as common land.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the revistration with the following medification:— the whole of the small triangular area of land abutting on Thurch Lane and comprised in the said Register Unit and a ten foot strip on the south and south—east sides of the remainder of the land comprised in the said Register Unit and abutting on the metalled carriage way to be removed from the Register.
