



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of the Village Green,  
Hinton-in-the-Hedges, Brackley R.D.,  
Northamptonshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.V.G.2 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Northamptonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.19 made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 19th October 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, which terms are that the said land was not a village green at the date of the registration but is and forms part of the public highway and that accordingly the Parish Meeting agree to the withdrawal of the registration of the land as town or village green.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registration.
