



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 26/D/2

In the Matter of The Village Green,  
Wappenham, Northamptonshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 21 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Northamptonshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 25 made by the County Council and noted in the Register on 19th October 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modifications :- namely the exclusion of

- (a) a strip of land 10 ft in width adjacent to the South Side of the Class III highway;
- (b) a strip of land 6ft in width between the churchyard wall and the south side of the unclassified highway; and
- (c) the area south of the Post Office telephone kiosk, but excluding the metalled footpath and a strip of land 4 ft in width immediately to the west of the footpath,

all of which are shown coloured red on a plan attached to the particulars of terms.
