

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 227/U/56.

In the Matter of land between Eland Hall and Mill Farm, Ponteland, Northumberland

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land between Eland Hall and Mill Farm, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 16 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Northumberland County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Mr R G Meek claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question, and Mr and Mrs T C Braithwaite claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Morpeth on 24 June 1982.

There was no appearance at the hearing. After the hearing a letter was received from a firm of Solicitors suggesting that Mr R G Mack might be the owner of an undivided moiety or possible the whole of the land in question. On 7 October 1982 the solicitors wrote to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners stating that an affidavit with exhibits would be prepared in support of Mr Mack's claim. This affidavit has not been forthcoming despite reminders dated 10 November and 7 December 1982 and 10 January and 18 February 1983, the last stating that unless the affidavit and exhibits were received by 25 March 1983, I would proceed with my decision.

In these circumstances I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
