



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 232/D/138 and 139

In the Matter of areas of Land to the West of  
Blackdown Shipham Sedgemoor D. Somerset.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section and Entry No.3 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL.162 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Somerset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. O/167 made by Sir John Wills Bart and noted in the Register on 18th November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Taunton on 21st May 1975.

Mr. Beeching Land Agent for the Coombe Lodge and Langford Court Estate appeared and submitted that there was an error in the Register map in that land in the Parish of Rowberrow had been by inadvertence included in this register Unit and Mr Beeching's submission was not contested by any person.

For these reasons I confirm the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section modified so as to exclude any land in the Parish of Rowberrow and the Entry at No.3 in the Rights Section modified so as to apply to the modified entry in the Land Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law, may within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
