

In the Matter of Land to the North-East of Dunkery Hill, Wootton Courtenay, Somerset (No. 2)

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 150 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Somerset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 0/812 made by the National Trust and noted in the Register on 23 August 1972 and Objection No. 0/9 made by Mr M Deakin and noted in the Register on 8 May 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration at Entry No. 1 with the following modifications:— namely the substitution for the words "The right to graze up to 230 sheep or 60 cattle and" in column 4 of the words "Grazing rights for 150 sheep or 30 cattle or" and the deletion of the words "and Hunscott" in Column 5, and I refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No. 2.
