



In the Matter of North Ham, Goose Marsh,
Catsford Common and Wall Common, Stogursey
and Otterhampton, Somerset (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. CL 84 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Somerset County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Taunton on 28 June 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr J M Lang and Mr F J House, two of the applicants for the conflicting registration. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the applicants for the registration.

In the absence of any evidence I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
