



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 232/D/136 and 137

In the Matter of pieces of Land West of Dunnett  
Farm and East of Cross Plain, Compton Bishop  
Sedgemoor D. Somerset.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entry Nos 4 5 & 6 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 89 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Somerset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No O/49 made by Sir N.J. Mordaunt and noted in the Register on 7th May 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of these disputes have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the said registrations.
