

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 232/D/189

In the Matter of The Green, Hambridge, Somerset

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Enty No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 182 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Somerset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 0/125 made by Mr R T Combe and noted in the Register on 5 January 1971.

I held a earing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Taunton on 9 and 10 May 1979. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

The registration was made on the application of Curry RivelParish Council. The grounds of Mr Combe's Objection were "that at the date of registration the property was not Common Land". In the absence of any appearance or evidence to support either the registration or the objection, the one relevant factor, as I see it, is that the registration is supported by the statutory declaration. In these circumstances, I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
