

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of (1) The Green, Comberford, (2) Hopwas Village Green, and (3) Wigginton Village Green, all in Wigginton, Lichfield District, Staffordshire

DECISION

These references relate to the question of the ownership of lands known as (1) The Green, Comberford, (2) Hopwas Village Green, and (3) Wigginton Village Green, all in Wigginton, Lichfield District being the lands comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit (1) No VG. 38, (2) No VG. 37 and (3) No VG. 36 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Staffordshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of these references no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the lands in question and no person claimed to have information as to their ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Lichfield on 13 December 1977. There was no appearance at the hearing.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the lands, and I shall accordingly direct the Staffordshire County Council, as registration authority, to register Wigginton Parish Council as the owner of the lands, under section 8(3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
