held a hearing (adjourned from 14 December 1982) for the purpose of inquiring nto the question of the ownership of the land at Colchester on 30 October 1984.

here was no appearance at the hearing by any claimant. In 1979 it was decided y Mr C A Settle, Commons Commissioner (Decision dated 28 March 1979) that the and in question is owned by the successors to the trustees appointed by a eed of Apointment dated 31 December 1926. It was not then or has it yet proved ossible to trace such successors, nor have new trustees been appointed. In person is the owner of the land, hese circumstances I am not satisfied that any nd it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act This will not prejudice an application by such successors, if traced f 1965. or appointed, for the question of ownership to be referred again by the egistration authority to the Commons Commissioner.
