

In the Matter of Roadside verges and subsoil of roads, Wortham Magpie Green, Wortham, Mid Suffolk D

DECISION |

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. 168 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Suffolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 149 made by Wortham Parish Council and noted in the Register on 31 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bury St Edmunds on 25 January 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr J O Davies, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Baron de Lancey, and by Mr R M W Rash, Chairman of Wortham and Burgate Parish Council.

Baron de Lancey was the applicant for registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section. Mr Davies told me that the claim to ownership was based in ownership of the lordship of the manor of which the Unit land is part, and that Baron de Lancey's successor is now the de Lancey Foundations. The Objection was withdrawn by the Parish Council. In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
