

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 234/D/93

In the Matter of Thorney Green, Stowupland Suffolk (No 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.CL.22 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Suffolk County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No.VG.68 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bury St. Edmunds on 13 February 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr H Hamel, Solicitor, on behalf of the Stowupland Parish Council the applicant for both registrations.

Mr Hamel informed me that the Parish Council did not wish to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
