nis reference relates to the question of the ownership of parts of the and described above being the parts of the land comprised in the Land ection of Register Unit No.CL.61 in the Register of Common Land aintained by the Suffolk County Council of which no person is egistered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

ollowing upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to e-the freehold owner of the land in question and no other persons laimed to have information as to its ownership.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the wnership of the land at Colchester on 30 October 1984. At the hearing R L Leggett, representing A W Mortier (Farms) Ltd, appeared but did ot claim ownership of the land in question: no claimant to ownership ppeared.

n the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the wner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection nder section 9 of the Act of 1965.

am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners egulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision s being erroneous in point of law, may within 6 weeks from the date which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state case for the decision of the High Court.
